

DANGEROUSLY DOUBLE-MINDED

The LORD said, “There is much, much compromise right now in My Church. Many, many are dangerously “double-minded”—saying one thing, but believing and doing another.

“I have and will continue to remove these from leadership—specifically, because I cannot allow this tainted and dangerous attitude to defile My Body.”

“Being double-minded is a strategy from the pit of Hell that has increased and succeeded. It stops one from receiving from Me fully,” says the LORD. “It stops one from walking in My fullness, from operational mountain-moving faith, being led by My Spirit, and so much more.”

“But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him. ⁶ But he must ask in faith without any doubting, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind. ⁷ For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord, ⁸ being a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways,” (James 1:5-8).

The LORD says, “It’s time for you to walk in a degree of faith that is ‘ever increasing.’ I am patient. My lovingkindness is with you. But My hands are tied when My people are living under double-mindedness. Honor and respect the faith that I have given you by *increasing* it. Never let your faith stay where it is—or at a standstill. This is a dangerous place to be and it will open holes for double-mindedness to come through.

2 Corinthians 11:3-4—*“But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ. ⁴ For if one comes and preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted, you bear this beautifully.”*

2 Corinthians 10:5-7—*We are* destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and *we are* taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ, ⁶ and we are ready to punish all disobedience, whenever your obedience is complete. ⁷ You are looking at things as they are outwardly. If anyone is confident in himself that he is Christ’s, let him consider this again within himself, that just as he is Christ’s, so also are we.”

Colossians 2:6-8—*“Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, ⁷ having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude ⁸ See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, rather than according to Christ.”*

Judas was double-minded (Mt. 27:1-6)! Think about that. He walked with the LORD daily and yet . . .

Thus, the LORD strongly commands us now, “Do *not* be double-minded! Those who embrace double-mindedness are dangerous and have the power to defile many.”

The LORD also showed me that the double-minded carry with them a high level of secret deceptions because they themselves are so deceived. They are prone to listen to many voices—but wrong voices—those who will speak to them what their itching ears want to hear. There is also confusion present along with a whole host of other issues that prevent one from following the LORD’s Will.

Then the LORD told me to tell His Church to STOP with any and all double-mindedness. He said there are too many who are messing around, posing and not serious. This is double-mindedness and as a result, they have and are compromising so much. NO MORE COMPROMISE.

“AWAKE!” Says the LORD. “Wake-up!”

I personally didn't want to hear this next Scripture, but I had to so I'll obediently pass it on. Just remember that when the LORD gives a warning; He is desiring to spare us, but also through Godly discipline empower us through onto good works—Revelation 2:2-3—*“Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God. ³ So remember what you have received and heard; and keep it, and repent. Therefore if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you.”*

The LORD continues, “TRUST in ME and TRUST ME with all your heart! Stand! Discern—be acutely aware of what you are believing, doing, and as well, defilement. Take responsibility.
