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THE SOUND OF RESURRECTION

Part 1

The Spirit of the LORD says, “My Church is in the SEASON of the SOUND OF RESURRECTION. I AM RELEASING the SOUND OF RESURRECTION. I AM ALLOWING My people to hear SOUNDS of RESURRECTION that they have not heard before! Many will ask: ‘What is that?’ because they have not heard it before. The RESURRECTION SOUND will release the discovery of new understanding—of new or further knowledge, of new development; that which one did not realize before. SOUND WITH LIGHT! Focus on this SOUND! I am baptizing My people in Resurrection Power! Holy Spirit’s Voice will be vibrating now through My people that they may HEAR the RESURRECTION!”

We must learn to allow the Holy Spirit to create a Resurrection atmosphere around us through the Sound of Resurrection.

In meditating on/thinking about this Word: First, I know that when the LORD gives a word that seems simple, it is not usually SIMPLE! *“It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, But the glory of kings is to search out a matter”* (Proverbs 25:2).

There is much more meaning in it to know and apprehend! Initially, and if we are not paying attention to the Holy Spirit’s voice, we can just shrug it off, and will miss the whole meaning—and even reject the entire word and its power for our life.

When I initially gave the word during a church service, I could sense it’s power, but felt totally unable to give it justice through my English words.

Second, when the LORD gives a word this (seemingly) simple, it is meant for each and every one of us to receive it by hearing and searching it out personally. In this case, that we might each individually and intimately hear the SOUND that is specifically related to the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Since the LORD said that He was going to *baptize* His people in the Sound of Resurrection—we must plan on being IMMERSED and mingled in it! In other words, we must plan to be covered deeply in it, not letting it go until we have given the Holy Spirit a chance to not only reveal to us more in it, but to change us through it!

Of course, as Believers in Christ Jesus, we are people of resurrection life. We know that the resurrection of Christ is the central truth and power of the Christian faith. That’s not the question or point here. The point here is that the resurrection is multi-faceted in its manifestation. In this case, resurrection has a sound.

Humans upon the earth are used to sounds relaying things to us. We are surrounded by sounds. These sounds speak to us without words being spoken. For instance, the sound of birds chirping lets me

know there are birds nearby. The sound of a siren lets us know there is a fire, emergency, etc. happening. Thunder lets us know a storm is brewing. Because I have a German Shepard, my dog barking lets me know something is happening—a person, truck, car or an unfamiliar animal is approaching. I know the sound/tone of my dog's barks. We can hear the sound of music with no lyrics, and it can touch and move us. Most know the sound of a trumpet blowing without us seeing it. You can often hear an airplane before you see it. In other words, our lives are packed full of sounds every moment of every day, with it being almost impossible for us to list them all.

In the case of the Sounds of Resurrection, the LORD is telling us to listen because Resurrection has more to manifest in this hour than we are familiar with or used to knowing. It will release its sound. In other words, yes, Jesus rose from the dead, He was resurrected, but it does not stop there (as we well know). It gives us eternal life. As if eternal life in Heaven was not enough, there is still more in the resurrection life of Christ!



THE SOUND OF RESURRECTION

PART 2

What is the Sound of Resurrection?

Truthfully, I don't believe we know or will fully know until we hear it! But I do believe it has to do with an actual sound and a position of soundness, as in soundness of mind. As well, that the particular Sound of Resurrection has been reserved for this season (as the LORD said)—i.e. for this specific Hour in time to not only make us aware and alert, but to empower us in a greater way. So, new sounds are coming forth—the sound of Resurrection.

Here are some definitions and high points about the Sound of Resurrection in which to meditate upon and consider:

- SEASON. First, God's people are in a new "season" of the Sound of Resurrection. There are many definitions for the term, *season*: 1) a time characterized by a particular circumstance or feature—as in a season of religious awakening. 2) a suitable or natural time or occasion—as in, when Christ's season comes to sit on David's throne. C) An indefinite period of time—as in, sent home again to her father for a season.

The Hebrew word for, *season*, is 'moed', translated in English as 'seasons'. Moed derives from the Hebrew word 'Ad' which means 'eternity' and refers to any FIXED time of the year—which will be marked for eternity (meaning forever).



Thus, the LORD is saying that we are in a season of Resurrection Sound which will be characterized not only by sight and knowing but by hearing its sound which will be marked for eternity. This season will indeed be a season of awakening and that awakening will be accompanied by the Sound of Resurrection.

The Greek word for "season" is "kairos". It can mean "*a certain definite time or season fixed by natural law and returning with the revolving year.*" However, it can also mean "*a suitable time or favorable moment or opportunity where you can take advantage of things coming to a head.*"

I believe the second definition is the most important to this season the LORD is referring to. However, we can easily attach the Greek definition with the English and Hebrew definitions.

Thus, on this meditation, I was thinking about the fact that this Resurrection Sound is an especially marked time for us to live now and in eternity. *It is a suitable time or favorable*

moment or opportunity where we can take advantage of things coming to a head. There is a great and final resurrection coming for us soon, however, to precede that, we will hear the arising sound of the finale first!

➤ SOUND. The word, sound, can go in a couple of different ways or directions.

Sound is first defined as A) A particular auditory impression or tone, B) The sensation perceived by the sense of hearing, C) Vibrations that travel through the air or another medium and can be heard when they reach a person's ear.

Sound is secondly defined as free from injury or disease or of sound mind; free from flaw, defect, or decay; solid, firm; stable, secure, reliable; free from error, fallacy, or misapprehension as in sound advice and sound reasoning; exhibiting or based on thorough knowledge and experience.

The Hebrew word for *sound* correlates with the English definition and means sound or voice; also thunder; tone. Sing/song. Event as in an earthquake. Efficient wisdom or sound wisdom/insight. Abiding success. Deliverance.

The Greek root word *phon* means "sound." This root word is the word origin of a number of English vocabulary words, including microphone, phone, and saxophone. An easy way to remember that *phon* means "sound" is through the word symphony, which is many instruments making a "sound" together.

Another Greek word for sound means *in good working order – hence, "healthy."* In other words, in *sound* condition (*in-balance*), "healthy, working well"; to be free from debilitation (incapacity, handicap) – hence, functioning *holistically* with all parts *working together* ("sound").

Because sound is slower than light, in the natural we can hear it. In the spiritual, however, we are able to hear sound (in and through our spirit) as well as see spiritual light. When we can develop our spirit to hear the sound of the Spirit's vibrating voice, we can then move into His LIGHT! The speed of light is constant while the speed of sound is not. In the spiritual case, Holy Spirit is in both sound and light!

In lieu of all of this, the Resurrection Sound the LORD is releasing in this season may be something we both HEAR with our spirit and a SOUND CONDITION the Body of Christ/the Bride of Christ must be in when He returns!



LIGHT is defined as something that makes vision possible or the natural agent that stimulates sight and makes things visible. It is also defined as A) spiritual illumination as in, “The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it” (John 1:5 (RSV); B) Inner light; C) Enlightenment, as in, reaching out and groping for a pathway to the light; D) Truth. In a Biblical sense, it is also revelation knowledge coming from Holy Spirit.

As mentioned, scientists tell us that the speed of light travels faster than the speed of sound. Wikipedia says this: “The speed of light in vacuum, commonly denoted c , is a universal physical constant that is exactly equal to 299,792,458 meters per second (approximately 300,000 kilometers per second; 186,000 miles per second; 671 million miles per hour).”

I call it Godspeed!

The speed of sound can only be heard through a medium—for sound in the natural, this medium is air, and that’s why sound does not exist in the emptiness of space.

The LORD said that this sound would travel with light, travel together. In other words, we will be on Heaven’s time or in Heaven’s season in this Resurrection Sound!

- RESURRECTION. The Hebrew meaning for resurrection is restore to life. It is related to the idea of *standing up or to stand up or rising up or to rise up*. Another Hebrew word for resurrection means *revival or rebirth*. This is basically the same definition in the Greek and English.

We are to rise-up, be restored to life being resurrected from death and all that death is to LIFE! “But He said to him, “Allow the [spiritually] dead to bury their own dead; but as for you, go and spread the news about the kingdom of God” (Luke 9:60). Let the dead bury the dead!

“Jesus said to her, “I am the Resurrection and the Life. Whoever believes in (adheres to, trusts in, relies on) Me [as Savior] will live even if he dies” (John 11:25).

“The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy LIFE, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows]” (John 10:10 AMP).

Jesus Christ IS RESURRECTION!

The thought on Resurrection for the Body of Christ (the Church) with Him as the Head of the Body is that we are to live and walk in the RESURRECTION NOW—or live and walk in JESUS CHRIST FULLY! However, as a prophet, I can definitively say that His Body is not fully walking in such! Thus, the reason for His voice speaking to us on this continually and the reason for Him to release such a season for us who live in these very Last Days with expectation of Christ’s soon Return!

We must be in a place where we are not just talking about Resurrection, but LIVING in the FULLNESS OF THE RESURRECTION LIFE CHRIST HAS GIVEN US. It is the only thing that will make us, His Body, ready as a pure and spotless Bride!

So, with all of this in mind, again, what is SOUND OF RESURRECTION? I believe it is the Fullness of Christ in which the Church is supposed to be walking in right now.

The two Greek words for *Salvation* are SOZO and SOTERIA which together denotes the powerful work of Jesus Christ. In other words, the fullness/completeness/ wholeness of Christ's Salvation: *To be saved, walking in eternal (zoē) life (now and forever), forgiveness, healing [soundness], deliverance [liberty/freedom/soundness], victory, restoration, preservation, prosperity, happiness/joy, protection [rescue/safety], harmony, help, rest, general well-being, peace/Shalom [complete wholeness].*

We must be listening in this Season for the Sound of Resurrection. We must!
