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## *Decision or Indecision?*

The Spirit of the LORD says, “My people suffer because of indecision and indecisiveness. These involve ‘doubt’. Many are in indecision and indecisiveness. If you are in indecision and indecisiveness, you are up and down, back and forth.

“When in indecision and indecisiveness, one cannot choose or make a choice—they are stationed in the middle.



*“And if anyone longs to be wise, ask God for wisdom and he will give it! He won’t see your lack of wisdom as an opportunity to scold you over your failures, but he will overwhelm your failures with his generous grace. Just make sure you ask empowered by confident faith without doubting that you will receive. For the ambivalent person believes one minute and doubts the next. Being undecided makes you become like the rough seas driven and tossed by the wind. You’re up one minute and tossed down the next. When you are half-hearted and wavering, it leaves you unstable. Can you really expect to receive anything from the LORD when you’re in that condition?”—James 1:5-8 TPT*

“You cannot move forward in indecision and indecisiveness. These are related to fear. I have not given you a spirit of fear, but of POWER, love, and a sound mind! *Have I not given you the power of GRACE?*

“I have called My people of this generation to ‘decision’ and ‘decisiveness’.” These equal faith.

“I cannot pour out My blessing anyone in the place of indecision and indecisiveness. I am destabilizing indecision and indecisiveness.

“What you decide, then stick to it—do not give in to indecision or indecisiveness because of what you may see in the natural! My Kingdom does not operate through the natural first. It operates through the supernatural first and foremost.

“I can only bless those who have made a firm decision and then are decisive and those who will go on to make wise choices from that point of decision by asking Me for wisdom!

“I am the One Who gives wisdom. All you need to do is “ask” and then believe I have given it to you! You decide first with your heart-spirit and then bring your mind into submission and obedience to it. Then start making choices based on such. You choose the right way or thing through My WISDOM and the FAITH I have given you.

Decide! Decide! Decide! Put your roots down! You cannot live in two places at once. Put your roots down so you can stabilize, function and produce!

“I have already instructed you to build My house, but many are building their own house [i.e. things you want to do] while My house lays in ruins.

*Haggai 1:7-10—“Thus says the Lord of hosts: Consider your ways (your previous and present conduct) and how you have fared. <sup>8</sup> Go up to the hill country and bring lumber and rebuild [My] house, and I will take pleasure in it and I will be glorified, says the Lord [by accepting it as done for My glory and by displaying My glory in it] <sup>9</sup> You looked for much [harvest], and behold, it came to little; and even when you brought that home, I blew it away. Why? says the Lord of hosts. Because of My house, which lies waste while you yourselves run each man to his own house [eager to build and adorn it]. <sup>10</sup> Therefore the heavens above you [for your sake] withhold the dew, and the earth withholds its produce.”*

The Spirit of the LORD says, “Your FAITH is built and strengthened on and what you decide through grace and then then choose to do. You must decide to follow Me into the impossible where much is unknown to you. You must decide to follow Me into My Kingdom.

“Follow Me into the impossible and the unknown—where your FAITH will increase, and your strength will increase through grace.

“Decide NOW to take up the Promises I have already given you and spoken over you. Choose them again—even though they tarry or seem long in coming, for you must linger in expectation to enter your season SEASON OF FULFILLMENT. This is no time to waiver, debate in indecision and indecisiveness. You MUST receive the promises NOW. You MUST GO FORWARD NOW! My promises are “Yes and Amen!”

“You are faced with only two choices: Move forward or stay immobile and do nothing more! In the latter, you will keep waiting.

*James 2:17-26 AMPC—“So also faith, if it does not have works (deeds and actions of obedience to back it up), by itself is destitute of power (inoperative, dead).<sup>18</sup> But someone will say [to you then], You [say you] have faith, and I have [good] works. Now you show me your [alleged] faith apart from any [good] works [if you can], and I by [good] works [of obedience] will show you my faith.*

*<sup>19</sup> You believe that God is one; you do well. So do the demons believe and shudder [in terror and horror such as make a man’s hair stand on end and contract the surface of his skin]! <sup>20</sup> Are you willing to be shown [proof], you foolish (unproductive, spiritually deficient) fellow, that faith apart from [good] works is inactive and ineffective and worthless?*

*<sup>21</sup> Was not our forefather Abraham [shown to be] justified (made acceptable to God) by [his] works when he brought to the altar as an offering his [own] son Isaac? <sup>22</sup> You see that [his] faith was cooperating with his works, and [his] faith was completed and reached its supreme expression [when he implemented it] by [good] works. <sup>23</sup> And [so] the Scripture was fulfilled that says, Abraham believed in (adhered to, trusted in, and relied on) God, and this was accounted to him as righteousness (as conformity to God’s will in thought and deed), and he was called God’s friend.*

*<sup>24</sup> You see that a man is justified (pronounced righteous before God) through what he does and not alone through faith [through works of obedience as well as by what he believes].*

*<sup>25</sup> So also with Rahab the harlot—was she not shown to be justified (pronounced righteous before God) by [good] deeds when she took in the scouts (spies) and sent them away by a different route?*

*<sup>26</sup> For as the human body apart from the spirit is lifeless, so faith apart from [its] works of obedience is also dead.*

### **Definitions:**

Indecision: *The inability to make a decision—to decide.*

Indecisive: *Not settling an issue quickly and effectively. I.e. doubtful, hesitant, tentative.*

Decision: *A conclusion or resolution reached after consideration.*

Decisive: ***Settling an issue; producing a definite result.***
